Ayurved College, Udaipur or at National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur where he worked for more than 37 years of his service period. Patients used to wait for long hours for their turn to obtain his consultation daily at his OPD units.

He is an authority in the Panchakarma procedures and treatment. His knowledge in Ayurveda is tremendous and extraordinary. He worked sincerely with devotion and occupied various positions in MMM Govt. Ayurved College, Udaipur as well as National Institute of Ayurved, Jaipur, where he moved up from the post of Demonstrator to the present esteemed position of Vice-Chancellor, the highest position for an academician. Prior to his joining to this position, he was Professor and Head of the Department of Panchakarma at National Institute of Ayurveda Jaipur, which is an apex Teaching and Research Institution of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India.

He was born on 17-09-1950 in a small village **Bagot** in Nagour district of Rajasthan. After his school education, he completed his BAMS (Ayurvedacharya) degree from BL Dugar Ayurved Vishwabharti, Sardarsahar and MMM Govt. Ayurved college, Udaipur in the year 1972. He studied under renowned Ayurvedic personalities like Vd. Sohan Lal Dadhich, Dr. S.K. Choudhary, Dr. Ved Prakash Sharma, Prof. Vasudev Shastri, Vd. Ramavatar Shastri, Vd. Dravyeshwar Jha and Vd. Gauri Shankar Shrotriya Ji.

He completed his Post Graduation in the subject of Kayachikitsa and Panchakarma under the supervision of renowned Ayurvedic personality Prof. Banwari Lal Mishra in 1982 and Ph.D. under the supervision of Prof. Vasudev Shastri in 1989 from National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur.

## **Government Service**

After completing his graduation in Ayurved, he joined as Demonstrator at MMM Govt., Ayurvedic College, Udaipur in 1972. He was selected at National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur in 1979 and worked as Lecturer, Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, RMO, Principal, Nursing College (NIA, Jaipur) and Professor and Head of the Department of Panchakarma till his retirement from NIA, Jaipur in 2010. He had an outstanding Post Graduate teaching and Research experience of more than 31 years and Under Graduate teaching experience of more than 37 years and acquired vast administrative experience at various levels and positions in MMM Govt. Ayurved college, Udaipur and NIA, Jaipur from 1972 to 2010.
